Obey Traffic Signs

Neighbors and Board Members have voiced concern about vehicles speeding through Westover. Dogs, kids, runners, walkers, contractors, and unexpected objects can appear quickly. Turning in from Skyport Road can be a cue to slow your speed.

The posted speed limits in Westover are 20 MPH and 25 MPH depending on which side of Skyport Rd you are travelling. Be mindful of stopping at ALL STOP SIGNS within Westover. There could be parked cars, walkers, runners, dog walkers, and kids who expect drivers will stop. Pedestrians have responsibilities as well and should do their part to stay visible, use established sidewalks, or stay as close to the curb on the road as possible.

Touch a Truck Day









Dear Westover Civic Association,

- **Q:** Can you tell people to slow down when they are driving in the neighborhood? I can't tell you how many people speed thru or think stop signs don't apply to them.
- A: We share your concern! Please read the notice on page 2. It doesn't matter if it is dark or you think you are the only car on the street. We all have a responsibility to pay attention in the moment to improve safe streets.
- Q: The street light is out in front of my house. Pretty sure this isn't an Association thing, but any idea who I call to get it fixed?
- A: Yes, street lights should all have a small silver placard located at eye level on their pole. Record the number on this placard and the street address of the pole. Call PPL at 1-800-DIAL-PPL (1-800-342-5775) to report street light outages or a broken light. You can visit the PPL Street Light website here. It may take several calls.

Dear Westover Willie,

- Q: I heard about the latest strain of avian flu in Pennsylvania. Anything I need to know if I like birds?
- A: Yes, a wild bald eagle was found dead in Chester County and the Pennsylvania Game Commission announced the detection of the Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI). The current outbreak is primarily an animal health issue and is low risk to the health of the general public. Always observe wildlife from a safe distance. Avoid contacting surfaces that may be contaminated with feces from wild or domestic birds. Practice proper hygiene including hand washing! You are probably used to this from the whole COVID-19 thing. My bird friends at ZooAmerica in Hershey are temporarily in quarantine for their safety. If you want more information, you can read the Game Commission Press Release here.
