The login will be through the Village of Westover website. Bear with us as we try this format and work to verify accounts for dues paying members. It is essential that we have your email address linked to your home address so please notify us of any changes.

This modernization of our directory will save costly printing and allow more timely updates. Also, if you are away from home and need to call a neighbor or send a postcard, you can access the information remotely on your smartphone. 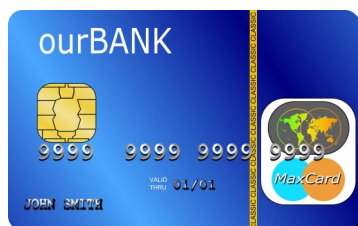
Residents, if you're not aware: Equifax, one of the 3 major credit bureaus, was hacked recently and approximately 143 million accounts were accessed. That's approximately 44% of the US population.

This is to warn you of a likely increase in reported ID theft/fraud and to also warn you to watch your own credit/identity as there is a very good chance your information may have been stolen.

Here is a link to both check on the likelihood you've been impacted and the ability to sign up for credit monitoring through Equifax; it is free. <https://www.equifaxsecurity2017.com/>

It's fairly common to have people contacted by an unknown person claiming to be with a police agency. The person will then tell the caller that their family member has been arrested and they need a certain amount of money immediately or they will remain in jail. The scammers gather information from the internet to further convince the caller that they have their grandson or who ever they claim to have. Police will not do this and they can contact our department if they receive one of these calls to help put their mind at ease.

Westover Mailbag

Dear Westover Civic Association,

Q: I've tried making a few local calls and am told to dial a 10 digit number. What happened? I have to change all my speed dials!

A: Ten digit dialing began in late August. An "overlay" code, 223, was established due the supply of 717 numbers being soon exhausted. Calls to 911 will not be affected, and calls that were local before will still be local (compared to long distance). The number planning area covers all or part of 16 counties in Central PA.

Q: When are the Board meetings and are residents able to attend?

A: Of course! All Civic Association members are welcome to attend our quarterly Board meetings. The next meeting is Wednesday, November 16 at 7pm at Good Hope Fire Station. Q: I hear the national anthem every morning at 8am. Do we have a patriotic neighbor or are you flying with a horn?

A: While we do have patriotic neighbors, the anthem is played at the Naval Support Activity Base. Depending on the breeze you can hear it throughout Westover. Some of my feathered friends like to sing along as there are plenty of flags in the neighborhood.

Q: The beautiful trees that line the streets and yards in Westover are losing their leaves already. Can you remind me of the leaf pick up schedule?

A: Yes! Hampden Township begins leaf collection mid-October and continues through December 1st with weather permitting. Westover leaf collection day is FRIDAY. Residents are asked to rake leaves into the street, a foot or so away from the curb or edge of pavement. Piles should not exceed three feet in height and four feet in width. Piles that contain tree branches or any other debris WILL NOT BE PICKED UP until the debris is removed. Debris damages equipment, and repairs are costly. Plus it just makes the crew have a bad day.
